Practice and examination.

Successful candidates will be awarded a certificate and will be required to complete a workbook over the following 12 months which will be require verification by a OHA/OHT/RN that the candidate has been working under supervision.

The candidate will be required to attend a ½ day refresher course and certification after 12 months.
